

**LAUNCHING/FIRST PUBLIC CONSULTATION WORKSHOP OF THE PROJECT
“ENERGY SAVINGS SIEM REAP – PROMOTING AND DEMONSTRATING
ENERGY CONSERVATION”**

4 April 2011, Siem Reap City, Cambodia

The Launching/First Public Consultation Workshop of the project “Energy Savings Siem Reap – Promoting and Demonstrating Energy Conservation in Siem Reap City, Cambodia” was organised by the Cambodian Ministry of Environment (MoE) in collaboration with its implementing partners, namely Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy (MIME); Royal University of Phnom Penh (RUPP); Cambodian Research Centre for Development (CRCDD) and UNEP Risoe Centre on 4 April 2011 in Siem Reap City, Cambodia. The objective of the workshop is to provide concerned stakeholders with related information about the project as well as to provide an opportunity to participants to discuss issues related to the project implementation.

Over 40 participants from concerned Government agencies, local authorities, and private sector attended this first consultation workshop. The workshop started with welcome and opening remarks by H.E. Kim Chhayhieng, Vice Governor of Siem Reap Province, H.E. Tun Lean, MIME Director General for Energy of the Ministry of Industry, Mine and Energy; and H.E.
